Catholic Schools Week!

Next week we will observe Catholic Schools Week here in our diocese. This week highlights the important responsibility we all have as Catholics to help support these schools that preach and teach the Gospel to our children. I realize that many Catholics would love to send their children to a faith-based school but simply cannot for any number of reasons. Nevertheless, these schools remain something all of us can treasure. I know many good Catholics “minister” in their teaching vocation in the public schools as well and their prayers and efforts are also a gift to the Lord.

I attended both Catholic and public schools in my childhood and can honestly say that I deeply preferred my Catholic school experience. It was always a blessing to be able to pray as a community of faith and talk openly and in a supportive environment about the Lord’s teachings. I especially remember having this grace in my challenging middle school years. At my public high school, I remember distinct moments where the Church and her teachings were dismissed or even chided by others. This was evident whenever morality and sexuality teachings arose (and that was some years ago!).

We are blessed to have so many of our children attending a variety of Catholic schools throughout our diocese. Here, at St. Thomas More, we have a special and even historical relationship with Msgr. Clarke School. This school grew out of the original St. Philomena School that was founded in our parish decades ago. The present Msgr. Clarke (named for one of our former pastors!) was the first real regional Catholic school in the diocese. The hard work of the Sisters of Notre Dame and the Sisters of the Cross and Passion provided the foundation that we continue to build upon today.

Today, the NEASC-accredited Msgr. Clarke School boasts approximately 400 students, 21 full-time and six part-time teachers, some of whom are also members of our parish. I have had the grace to become a part of Msgr. Clarke, celebrating Mass and visiting and teaching the children. What a grace to have such a great school as part of our parish “campus”. Perhaps you know someone that could benefit from exploring a Catholic education. At the very least what we should all do is pray for our Catholic school families that they may come to know Christ more deeply and pray especially for the schools in the inner-city that are at risk of closure. It is sad that our state will not support tuition tax credits or vouchers to help the Church educate more cheaply and more efficiently while saving tax dollars....we can only hope and pray that this policy will change!
