

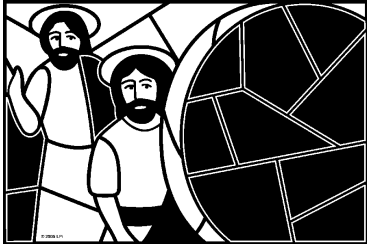

***He is Risen – Alleluia!***

“The Lord is risen and he has appeared to Simon!” Luke 24:34.

This passage is perhaps the oldest testimony of the resurrection of Christ from the dead. Simple, yet bold proclamations are what began the nucleus and the core of our Christian faith! We know that Jesus, who was “from the beginning” never died. He came into our world in order to *conquer death and our sins for us*.

Jesus is the fulfillment of the promise foreshadowed in the Old Testament. At the time of Jesus, the Jews would have been well familiar with the biblical gift and word that God had shared with them about the promise of the Messiah.

The gift of Easter is one for all humanity. We have been promised, by the blood of Jesus and his resurrection, that our bodies too in death will be reanimated. This part of Easter so central is today often overlooked or even sadly dismissed as unimportant.

Jesus, unlike Lazarus or the young man in Naim who were reanimated, “appeared” after his resurrection and “made himself seen”. Jesus belongs to a sphere no longer perceptible to our senses, but to the world of God. He can therefore only be seen by one to whom He grants it (Pope Benedict).

Easter can only be “seen” by the heart, spirit in the inward part of a person. Can you “see” it? Jesus passed from death to life in accordance with the scriptures, on the third day and rose from the dead. Later, he appeared to his disciples. Today He appears and comes to us in the Eucharist to give us new life and hope. Jesus is risen...Alleluia!
