



This week we have a guest columnist, Dr. Rick Ohnmacht, a pediatrician who accompanied our mission trip to the Dominican Republic. He felt compelled to share with our parish the graciousness and graces that our teen missionaries gave that he shared and observed. Parents, catechists, and parishioners should be very proud and joy-filled. Videos are still available on the parish website.

I am sorry that I could not speak with you personally after our mission trip, but I appreciate being able to share some thoughts with you. First I would like to personally thank you for the opportunity to travel to a place with so many needs and to help, even in some small way. It is an experience I will never forget.

I'd like to share some thoughts about your kids, who represented both St Thomas More and our diocese. You should all feel extremely proud of their work, their commitment to their faith and their kindness and caring. First, while the Dominican Republic is a tropical country, this was not a resort vacation. It was quite warm and ceiling fans provided the only cooling. The food, while very good was not plentiful and as the father of a teen, having nineteen 15-17 year olds give up texting, cell phones and even I-pods for eight days is a miracle in itself. Finally the toilets-- I'll leave that one for them to detail!

When we arrived at the orphanage, I observed a transformation unlike any I've ever witnessed. Most of our kids had never seen a multiply handicapped child and were understandably quite anxious about what to expect. Within a few minutes, everyone had one or even two resting comfortably in their laps. Whether on the beach, in the Cathedral or just on the back porch, the missionaries never stopped caring for these children. They would often pull me aside just to have me take an additional listen to that one special child with whom they were particularly concerned.

Your missionaries worked tirelessly and without complaint. They painted both inside and out, inventoried supplies and helped in the caring of the orphans. They supported each other in times of joy and times of distress. They prayed together, shared together and left a mark on the orphans and orphanage that will not be forgotten. A recent visitor to Hogar Immanuel commented how wonderful the building looks, how healthy the children appear and how fondly the staff remember our missionaries. I am sure our kids will tell you how much grace they received, but we must not forget how much they gave.
