Fr. Adam Young!***

This is the last week in the Church's celebration and prayer in the Year for Priests. I have fond memories of our twenty-four hour vigil for priests and seminarians that began this a year ago and your overwhelming prayer-filled response before the Eucharist. As the year comes to a close, I am pleased to announce that **Bishop Tobin has assigned one of our to-be-ordained Fr. Adam Young to St. Thomas More for the summer beginning on July 1st!**

Fr. Young (along with Frs. Joseph Upton and Derek Puleo) will be ordained to the Priesthood next Saturday at 10am at the Cathedral of SS. Peter and Paul. Fr. Young will celebrate his first Mass at his home parish of St. Francis de Sales in North Kingstown on Sunday, June 27th.

Fr. Young is a joy-filled and dynamic servant. I have fond memories of him coming to Our Lady of Providence Seminary when he was just fifteen years old to let it be known he was discerning the priesthood. He remained active in our St. John Vianney high school group throughout his time at North Kingstown High School. He subsequently joined the seminary and attended Providence College. Later, he was assigned to the North American College in Rome where he is now half-way done completing a Licentiate Degree in Ecumenism (the dialogue among Christian traditions). He will begin his priestly ministry here for the summer and then return to Rome for nine months to finish his degree and then return to our diocese for another parish assignment.

I can't help but think of the providential gift of closing the year for priests praying for your priests and seminarians and preparing to welcome one of our newly ordained. May Fr. Young's priestly ministry be blessed and fruitful.
