A heartfelt "thank-you" to those who worship at St. Thomas More Church. Over the last nine days our facility did not receive enough voltage to run our commercial grade chiller. With great difficulty we are able to prove that fact. The end result was the burning out of our compressors (the first one during our Feast Mass) and the second one last weekend. This past Tuesday our new compressors were installed at a cost of well over \$10,000. I am in the process of making an appeal to the electric company for reimbursement to us for the damage incurred. Gratefully the one compressor worked for the wedding that happened last Friday evening and the bride and groom prayed in a comfortable atmosphere. Special thanks to James our facilities manager who was here often over the weekends and nights to measure voltage and keep things moving.

Fr. Young has moved into the rectory and has begun his ministry among us. I had met him when he was just 14 years old and a freshman at North Kingstown High School. He remained active in our high school discernment group and later on we lived together at Our Lady of Providence Seminary. He will remain with us until he returns to Rome for nine months in the fall to finish his Licentiate Degree in the Fathers of the Church. It is a grace he is with us as he begins his priestly ministry. His ordination and First Mass at St. Francis de Sales, North Kingstown were graced, beautiful and moving. Let's keep all our seminarians in our prayers as well as those intentions for vocations.

Several have asked about the pilgrimage to Rome in the fall. It is now full and booked at this time.

The summer mass schedule is in full swing and it stretches our ministries and sacristans to be sure. Our parish is famous for its warm welcome to guests and visitors alike as we share God's nature and beauty in our area.
