JULY 15, 2012

“Even Though Mother and Father forsake you, I Will Not Leave You...” Psalm 27

It is with great gratitude that I share with you, that this week in the Dominican Republic, a corporal work of mercy will be happening that is special.

The Hogar Immanuel Mustard Seed Orphanage where we have sent missionaries the last four years is a special place to our faith community. The twenty one disabled children “ninos” find their only real family among St. Thomas More where many of our college-aged missionaries and chaperones are united to them as godparents and spiritual friends.

In the last few years, four of the orphans have passed away including Johanne who died of malnourishment and complications shortly after we arrived back last November.

Two years ago while we were there, a teenager from the local village had committed suicide and I was privileged to celebrate his funeral on the first day of our arrival. This past year the young man’s best friend, who has helped us each time we visit, wanted to take me to the cemetery to visit the grave of his friend we had buried. I visited his grave with three of our teen missionaries (Wil, CJ and Andy) It was at this cemetery that I realized that the orphans that we had loved, baptized and buried were interred separately at the boundaries in unmarked graves. There were no markers, no way to know who and where they were. I shared this with some of our parishioners upon our return. I am happy to say that because of the generosity of some of our parishioners, the four orphans’ bodily remains will be exhumed and re-interred and placed all together in the cemetery and a fitting marker will be placed there indicating their names, date of birth and entrance into eternal life. The marker will also indicate that they are members of St. Thomas More Parish family. The project should be completed within the next ten days and hopefully we can obtain a picture that we can post on our website and in our bulletin.

Please pray for Hogar Immanuel and the 21 remaining children who breathe and give more love than they receive each day. Pray that the Lord may bring us back to them to feed, clothe and pray with them.

During these days of summer when many of us are afforded vacation time to relax and gather with friends and family, let our orphans and their simple and complete reliance upon God for everything remind us of our blessings and call us to deeper love and service to the needy within our reach daily.
