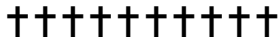

Organic History 101

The pipe organ at St. Thomas More Church has an amazing history that I thought you might find interesting. I recently stumbled upon an article in the Evening Bulletin from November 1990 about the just then completed \$42,000 renovation of the organ which took place in Deerfield, NH by George Bozeman.

It was built by the highly regarded Hooks and Hastings and contains over seven hundred pipes. It was first installed in a church in Westfield, NJ and then moved to a church in New York City. It was purchased for St. Thomas More by Zenaide and Alexine Bouvier. The Bouvier sisters, aunts of Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis lived next door to the church and were faithful parishioners also commissioning the pulpit and presiders chair which were recently restored to St Thomas More Church. The Bouviers paid \$400.00 in the 1920's (an enormous sum in those days!) and in 1990 was valued at over \$200,000.00. There is a small and simple plaque noting this on the organ console.

In 1990 Paul Ladd was the parish organist and oversaw the restoration project. In 1990 there was a dedication concert in which eight organists from throughout Rhode Island played on the newly restored instrument.

Imagine for a moment how many prayers, psalms and canticles have been sung by the countless souls who have been led to prayer by this standard yet special organ here in our parish and in New York and New Jersey.

Our organ tucked up in the loft is now played by Ed Rashed our organist who shows the organ the respect it deserves and the rigors it demands. This storied musical instrument reminds us of the consistency of the prayer life over the years in our parish and the importance of sacred music in prayer. Let us keep in grateful prayer all those who labor in music ministry in our parish and provide such quality and committed service.
