Operation Thanksgiving to be Launched!

It is with great enthusiasm and hope that I can announce that St. Thomas More parish will adopt the US Army 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment currently deployed to Afghanistan. One member of this unit, Jack Dignan, worships here with us and is very dear to me. It has come to my attention that some of the troops do not receive very much support or mail as I had presumed. In addition, winter is coming on in that part of the world and it is brutally cold soon. Some of the soldiers do not have the financial or emotional support that others have that provide them with the additional supplies or items that could really help them.

Steve Crawford and I have come up with three different levels of thanks-giving. The first is to be a *Spiritual Supporter*. You would take the name of a soldier and offer some specific prayer for them (holy hour, rosary, etc.) then write them (preferably handwritten) sharing with them that you are praying for them and on occasion sending them cards/greetings with your prayers and support.

Some soldiers do not have families or friends that could provide them with gear and supplies outside of standard issue. A *Benefactor* would provide some of these items which are pricier but can really help a soldier survive (goggles, gloves, equipment, army-approved clothing, etc). We will provide websites that will present a wide range of products/supplies that can be purchased and sent to these young men to help them remain safe and alert and healthy. In addition, a letter, prayer, and spiritual adoption would ensue.

A *Supplier* would provide less expensive but helpful supplies that would be specified (i.e. pens, individually-wrapped hard candies, cigarettes to barter with the local population, travel coffee mugs with lids).

We have done our homework to identify what is really needed. Next week's bulletin and website will provide specific details. Our office here will be the headquarters for all of this so that we can track the equitable distribution of our parish's thanks-giving to all those soldiers. Let us pray for them every day.
