***Operation Thanksgiving: A Lesson in Perspective***

I've been remembering a poem written by Emily Dickinson that addressed the subject of *perspective* in a powerful way. She wrote that "*success is counted sweetest/By those who ne'er succeed,*" that the clearest "*definition of victory*" is best told by "*he, defeated on whose forbidden ear the distant strains of triumph burst agonized and clear!*"

There's a lot of truth in that message. Oftentimes we don't appreciate what we have until we don't have it. As I battle these past few days with a very bad cold I am reminded that I take my usual good health for granted. And that instead of whining about how miserable I feel I should be thanking God for the good health he has graced me with for most of my life.

Perspective: Oftentimes, for most of us, it teaches us to see the bigger picture, and when we do we are humbled by the great blessings God has bestowed upon us.

***Operation ThanksGiving***, the new initiative undertaken by St. Thomas More parish, is about perspective. Far, far away from the comfortable confines of a Narragansett life a group of young men, members of a US Army Stryker Cavalry Regiment, are serving our country in a desolate and dangerous outpost in Afghanistan. Many of these soldiers have lived lives very different than ours, lives constrained by circumstances not always of their own making. Regardless of where our politics may be, all of us recognize the sacrifice they are making, standing in harm's way separated from family and loved ones for a long period of time. My complaining about my cold embarrasses me when I step back and see the bigger picture. Perspective.

And so that is why our ***Operation ThanksGiving*** initiative is so important, and why it needs everyone's participation. We have adopted this regiment of young men in a spirit of great thanksgiving for the many blessings which we have been given and in great thanksgiving for what these young men have given to us and their country. To show our appreciation we are asking everyone to consider "adopting" one of these soldiers, and sending him news of your prayers, cards, letters, supplies, toiletries, etc. We have over 40 names in our office now, so stop by or call and we'll get the easy process started. Many parishioners have already stopped by this past week, but we still have many soldiers who will be so grateful to hear from you. Please stop by and let us introduce him to you!
