The New Roman Missal42 days and counting!

We continue our preparations for the implementation of the New Roman Missal that will take place in all the English-speaking countries in the Catholic Church.

We have purchased and received cards that will be placed in all our pews on the weekend of November 5th.

These cards will have all the new responses and prayers in them to be read and prayed with the new words in colored red italics to make it easier to see what is new. Hopefully this will spur all of us to enter more deeply in the meaning of the words we pray at holy mass, Please take the time to look at (but not take home!) these cards after mass.

On the weekend of November 12th and 13th Fr. Fisette and I will be addressing everyone at both churches about the upcoming changes and how this may seem cumbersome at first but will render our verbiage more faithful to the original Latin texts from which they were taken.

There are excellent and simple videos on our website and Facebook page put out by Life Teen that are good for all ages to listen to and help us understand what is happening.

The majority of the changes are really for the priest to pray. There will be new Eucharistic Prayers and some minor adjustments to some acclamations that we sing.

Overall, this is a great opportunity for grace and growth in understanding the authentic biblical roots of our prayer at Mass. The Eucharist is, of course, the height and center of our lives on earth and in our daily lives. These changes come to us as a gift from the input of thousands of people over several decades. While perhaps not the last change that will ever happen, it is the one for our times.
