Thanks to the parishioner/donor who has stepped forward to gift a new sign for St. Veronica Chapel. I assure all that the sign will be designed to be dignified, consonant with our beautiful property and is a work in progress. I will meet the the sign company for a re-design and re-submission to planning/zoning at a later date. My absence from the initial meeting caused much confusion and has made me more sensitive to be sure. I find it providential that last weekends Gospel was 'render to Caesar what Caesar's and to God's what is God's'!

The New Roman Missal is coming November 27th. Fr. Fisette and I will preach and teach about it on the weekend of November 12 and 13th. ***The pew insert/cards will be placed in the pews beginning on November 5 and 6th and will remain there. Please do not remove these cards ever.*** They need to remain in the churches indefinitely. We have begun to use the new memorial acclamation and Sanctus (Holy, Holy). The words to these have been placed in the rear cover of the plastic covers for the Missalettes in both churches. The new words will of course be in the new Missalettes once they are changed for the New Missal weekend on November 26th.

We have purchased two new Roman Missals for each church. There is a Memorial opportunity if someone is interested whereby the deceased loved ones name would be placed in the inside cover of the Sacramentary (red book that priest prays the sacred prayers from at each Mass) and is placed on the Altar of Sacrifice.
