### *What makes a Saint?*

This past week we heard about Pope Benedict canonizing six new saints. Two of them Mary McKillop of Australia (their first-ever saint) and Brother Andre Bessette (Canada's first male saint with a RI connection) have garnered much attention in our part of the world. Some parishioners have asked "how does that work...how does one become publicly canonized?"

To be honest it is an arduous and tedious process. After the death of someone who is renowned for outstanding holiness and sanctity there are many believers who feel close to the deceased and begin intercessory prayers for them (similar to Mother Teresa and John Paul II). After some time if the spiritual movement continues a bishop may move to formally open a cause for that person and a postulator is appointed to gather all information and documents as well as testimony from as many sources as possible to begin to formulate a case for public veneration and gifts in the person's earthly life. They are considered Venerable. If someone receives a verified miracle by the intercession of that venerable person, he/she would then be declared "Blessed". Once the case continues it is scrutinized by the "devil's advocate" who examines the case for weaknesses. When three miracles are verified then the saint is declared a public saint of the Church in a ceremony usually presided over by the Pope himself. Such was the case last Sunday for these six "Blesseds".

Now let's make sure we know the person is already in heaven when they are canonized but the process and declaration makes them a role model, friend and intercessor for others in the Body of Christ to emulate. Public veneration becomes a formal reality.

It is especially wonderful that St. Andre Bessette was a poor young boy with nine brothers and sisters when his father died leaving his mother a widow at forty. He was not well-schooled and jumped job-to-job to help his family. He immigrated to the US and worked in the textile mills for four years spending time in Rhode Island! He returned to Canada and entered the Brothers of the Holy Cross in Montreal. He was assigned the lowly task of porter to welcome guests, wash the floors and deliver messages. He became renowned for welcoming the sick and encouraging all to pray to St. Joseph to obtain graces from Christ. Many miracles of physical healing but even more healings of the interior spirit of those he prayed with were realized. Today the Oratory of St. Joseph (not so many hours from Narragansett) is arguably the most impressive shrine to St. Joseph in the world.

As All Saints Day approaches us on November 1<sup>st</sup> (and election day is All Souls Day November 2<sup>nd</sup> when we pray for the dead) let us remember we are all called to be saints, to love and follow Christ, to heal others with prayer and charity. The saints, too, are our friends. Let us go a bit deeper this season to knowing them, seeking their intercession and imitating their great love for Christ and the Church.
