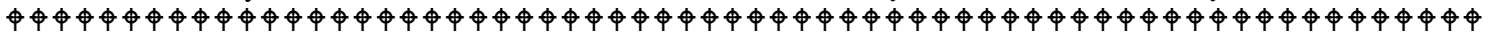

It is a good time to reiterate that eulogies should be shared at the vigil service at the home, the cemetery or in a more relaxed way at the reception after the burial. Eulogies have become less and less liturgically appropriate and while obviously well-intentioned and heartfelt, they often inadvertently detract from the holy sacrifice of the Mass for the deceased and are often not a reflection of the deceased person’s faith life. Please prayerfully consider how burial rites are planned to insure they speak and point to the heart of the Easter hope and promise Christ has given us. I hope you can join us on All Souls Day for 7pm Mass of Remembrance at St. Thomas More. All are welcome to come and pray for the dead and in a special way for those who lost someone this past year.

May the souls of the faithful departed Rest in Peace!
