Operation Thanksgiving Update

Many thanks to the parishioners who have adopted a soldier from the 2nd Calvary Regiment. This unit is deployed in Afghanistan and is composed primarily of young Army infantry. They have sustained casualties and injuries in the weeks since they have been deployed from their base in Germany.

Many have contacted me via Facebook which, although very limited, seems to be the main means of communication with family and friends. One of the soldiers recently sent a message reading, "Thanks so much...I am sure no one has any idea how these packages have helped us. God bless you all!"

Our own soldier Jack Dignan recently shared that he feared that some of the soldiers would not be returning a thank you for a number of practical reasons. They are often out on long missions and return to the base for brief rest and break. There is often little downtime left in light of the ongoing combat operations and preparations for various missions. Sometimes they are out for days and mail doesn't come for several weeks for delivery. In addition, some soldiers have been injured and may not be able to respond and to be frank some simply would not have had formation from their family backgrounds that would have enlightened them on what should be done. Jack wanted all of us to know the profound impact that the arrival of the packages has had on all the men. Several of the soldiers have not really received any mail since deployment. He wanted me to stress and emphasize the amazing effect our prayers are having on the men as well.

There are more soldiers to adopt. The three levels of adoption are explained online or in a flyer available at the parish office or on the church doors. With a great shortage of chaplains and access to sacraments combined with the stress of day-to-day combat our prayers, packages and support are helping one very appreciative group of men.

If you do hear from your soldier if you could kindly let the rectory know so we can keep track of some of the impact and preferences of some of our men.

Thanks for all you do. May the Lord bless and keep them and may you be blessed for your prayers and generosity.
