Come Experience the The Divine Office! (or Liturgy of the Hours)

The Liturgy of the Hours is the prayer of the Church and when we pray it we pray with our brothers and sisters throughout the world. Jesus said, “pray continually and never lose heart (Lk 18:1).

The Divine Office breaks the day into the Office of Readings (a hymn, three psalms, a reading from Sacred Scripture and a reading from a saint), morning prayer, mid-morning, mid-day, mid-afternoon and evening prayer. It really brings scripture and pause throughout the day.

Who prays this? The ordained clergy together with religious have a mandate to pray this prayer of the church for all. It is through them that the prayer of Christ may persevere in the Church. Amazing to think that there are clergy and religious (and countless laity) praying the “office” as it is called all around the world right now. I will never forget when I was a seminarian on pilgrimage to Poland in 1992. I, along with two other American seminarians was in the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa. We were carrying our breviaries (the book that contains the divine office) and saw that several Polish seminarians also had their book and were about to pray evening prayers. We didn’t speak any Polish and they didn’t speak a word of English but we were able to pray and alternate the readings since they were identical in our native tongues and books. It was the first time I had really experienced and tasted the Church always at prayer.

In monasteries the monks and nuns often chant or pray the office. We play chanting of the Office in both our churches prior to the musicians beginning in order to help us enter into prayer and recollection. Most often the Office is read and not chanted outside of monasteries and religious communities. I usually pray the Office alone and enjoy when brother priests are here to pray with me.

This Sunday evening at 6pm in St. Thomas More we all have a chance to pray and chant the Office for Sunday Vespers for the First Sunday of Advent. Ed Rashed will lead our music and our dear friend Fr. Timothy Reilly will offer a brief reflection to start our new liturgical season and year.

With all the hustle and bustle that will try to engulf us won’t you come to spend a 45 minute time to listen or chant some evening vespers? Let our parish join in the perpetual and rich prayer of Christ in His Church. I hope I see you there!
