My life will change significantly. I will move to Washington, DC, this week and be extensively traveling in the months ahead to seminaries, military installations, and wherever I can support our priests who are already preparing to serve.

There are no words to convey my gratitude for all the love and support you show each other each day and the faith life you often live at the foot of the cross. I will miss you and our parish very much. I ask for your prayers in the challenging but exciting months ahead.

I have included a picture of where I will live and work and invite you to sign up for the "Salute" magazine that comes quarterly to get to know the excellent work of our priests and seminarians at the archdiocese. May we walk together while we are apart in Jesus the High Priest.



Stations in the Streets On Good Friday we carried the Cross of Jesus through the streets of Narragansett.




