

St. John Vianney

Is there a doctor in the house?

Recently, Pope Leo named St. John Henry Newman as "doctor" of the Church. This rare distinction is awarded to someone whose contributions and writings have significantly benefited the entire Church. He wrote on the nature of faith and reason and converted to Catholicism from Anglicanism in 1845. There are only 38 doctors of the Church in the history of the Church.

August is my favorite month for saints on the calendar. This past week, we remembered St. John Vianney, patron saint of parish priests. He, against all odds and despite some academic limitations, transformed his small, remote parish in France through prayer and pastoral life into a vibrant, sacramental community that loved Jesus.

Other notable saints this month include St. Clare of Assisi on August 11th, St. Maximilian Kolbe on August 14th, St. Rose of Lima on August 23rd, and St. Monica and St. Augustine, mother and son, on August 27th and 28th.

You may have heard that Pope Leo verified a miraculous healing of a child years ago in Memorial Hospital in Pawtucket. The doctor invoked Father Salvador Parra, who may be beatified due to this medical miracle. I drove by the now-closed and abandoned building on Route 95 the other day. Strange, how now that building is a place where God's direct intervention and a saint's intercession have and will affect so many.

As the end of summer draws near, spend some time in August getting to know at least one of these saints. They are ordinary people who are sinners who, by God's grace, have persevered in faith, hope, and charity.






