## Honoring our Past... Consecrating our Future

It has been quite some time since our Capital Campaign was launched in 2017. I recall that we chose this name since it invited us to give thanks to God for how our parish began in such a humble and little way back in 1884 in a chapel where the courtyard is today on Rockland Street. Once affiliated with St. Francis in Wakefield, we were now to be our own parish.

In 1994 Bishop Harkin gave permission to build the larger church we enjoy today. On Sunday July 19, 1908 the Bishop celebrated the first Mass at 6:20 AM. In 1960, St. Mary Star of the Sea would leave St. Thomas More and break off also to be her own.

There was a cinder block chapel on land on Boston Neck Road that was owned by the Diocese of Providence. It was given to the Diocese by J. Howard Mcgrath, the US Attorney General. Under the leadership of Msgr. Halloran, the land was given to our parish and the chapel was built. The formal dedication of the new church was in 2000. The additional hall and classrooms were dedicated in 2003.

This particular capital campaign, Honoring our Past...Consecrating our Future, saw the complete renovation of the St. Thomas More parish hall and the addition of a new kitchen on Rockland Sreet. The last phase of this campaign is the enhancement of the parking lot at St. Veronica. While still not complete, we thought it would be good to pause and celebrate all the history of our parish and to pray for all those that have gone before us in their faith lives who have entrusted these days to us. We look forward to the day we can receive all of our worshippers and countless visitors in a safe and pleasant atmosphere. The heavy landscaping will take place in September, and then the second layer of asphalt and final lines will be painted.

A word of thanks to all the donors who made all this possible as well as the architects, engineers and workers who have done outstanding work over the last several years.

Let us remember that we are consecrating our future which is to say we entrust it to Jesus Christ. The most important thing in our churches are the altars of sacrifice and our tabernacles, as well as you! God has blessed our parish with growth and vibrancy. Let us celebrate today all that God has done for us, and promises to do.

Let's honor our past and consecrate our future.
