## *Eucharistic Miracles and Homebound Ministry*

Recently I was blessed to go on pilgrimage with priest friends to Italy. One of our journeys was to visit the body of St. Rita of Cascia. She is an amazing saint with so many varied apostolates and vocations. Under the basilica where she was, I discovered one of the Eucharistic miracles of a host turning to blood. In 1330, a priest was to take Holy Communion to a homebound peasant. He carelessly placed the host in his prayer book instead of the customary container to protect the host. When he got there and opened his book he was shocked to discover the change. He immediately repented for his apathy and carelessness. I took this picture of the pages still stained with the blood.



It reminded me of our homebound Eucharistic ministry. I prayed for all our homebound and extraordinary ministers that bring communion to them. Do you or someone you know need the Eucharist brought to them at home because they can't go out? Some have disabilities or need time to recover after surgery and can't make it to Mass in person. You would simply call the rectory and request this. Our Extraordinary Ministers are faithful and become spiritual friends to our brothers and sisters.

Are you in the hospital? All hospitals have chaplains/ Extraordinary Ministers of Communion to bring Jesus to you during your stay. Simply ask for the chaplain's office and they will send someone. South County is very responsive to this as are other hospitals. If you are admitted to the hospital, most often the clergy will not know. In the "old" pre Covid days we could tell if members of our parish were admitted. This is no longer the case so be sure to let us know.

Summer is here and is a great time for families, teachers and others to attend daily Mass or visit the Blessed Sacrament at St. Thomas More during the daytime. The Eucharist IS God. Countless Eucharistic miracles remind us of this.

Let us pray we become hungrier for Christ and His body.





## CHANGES TO BE MADE

Last Sunday's "Parable of the rich fool" delivered a compelling reason to do the right thing—now: "You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you." Today, Jesus warns us: "You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." Though we do not know when our Master will come, we do know what our Master expects to find. Jesus expects us to be vigilant and diligent in our work for the kingdom, but also filled with reverent mercy toward our fellow servants and ourselves. What changes do I need to make, right now, so that the many people outside "the Master's house" will want to come inside to experience the healing comfort of Jesus' own mercy in the compassion of Jesus' modern-day disciples?

### VIGILANCE

Today Jesus proposes an attitude universally countercultural: vigilance. Whatever our other differences, we moderns dread delay; we hate to wait! All three readings call us to faith-filled vigilance, "focused" waiting, holy patience. In communion with our ancestors across the centuries—those to whom Wisdom and Hebrews were addressed—we, recalling the Rich Fool's sudden demise, must work, witness, and worship in this world with our hearts set on the future that God has prepared for us, the fulfillment of bold and beautiful promises: deliverance from threats without and burdens within, a heavenly homeland, a city yet to come. Well might all of us called to spiritual vigilance also spare a thought for those who work while others sleep—police, firefighters, first responders—making our own the night prayer attributed to Saint Augustine: "Keep watch, dear Lord, with those who wake, or watch, or weep tonight, and give your angels and saints charge over those who sleep. Tend your sick ones, O Lord Christ, give rest to the weary, bless the dying, soothe the suffering, pity the afflicted, shield the joyous; and all for your love's sake. Amen."

### DILIGENCE

Our watchfulness is to be not only prayerful but service-oriented, that active-contemplative balance so often proposed by Luke's Jesus. Though ignorance of the master's wishes may win some a reprieve, Jesus presumes that we who are listening to him now will not qualify for such mitigation. Using Luke's favorite image of table fellowship, Jesus depicts the master "girding" himself, just as the disciples have been told to do, and serving the servants who persevered in their service of watching and working. How often we brush off a thank-you from others by saying, "It was the least I could do!" And, sadly, how often we do the least we can! But true discipleship, in Luke's perspective, is not settling for the least we can get away with until our master's return, but getting ready by always being ready for his kingdom to come.

**W**hen someone returns to God, they leave a physical void in the parish and their family. As the Director of Faith Formation, one of my greatest blessings is the celebration of First Holy Communion. Every year I am struck by the children's love and closeness to Jesus which strengthens my own faith. These children most likely know more about the Eucharist than most adults. In fact, recent studies have shown that only one-third of Catholics believe in the True Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. As heartbreaking as that statistic is, there is hope.

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has launched a multi-year National Eucharistic Revival Project. Why a revival on the Eucharist? According to the Revival Project's website, their mission is to "renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist." This revival aims to inspire and educate. Phase one of the revival is on a diocesan level which began on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, June 19th of this year, and will end on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi next year. The second phase will foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level and will start on June 11, 2023 and go until July 17, 2024. I want to share with you an inspiring story about a teenager named Carlo Acutis. Like most boys his age, he enjoyed playing soccer and video games. Carlo also had an interest in computer programming. However, his greatest love was for Jesus in the Eucharist. After receiving First Holy Communion, his desire for the Eucharist grew. Carlo would tell his friends, "The more we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of heaven." Carlo would explain that "Jesus is really present in the world, just as when, in the time of the Apostles, the disciples could see him in flesh and blood walking the streets of Jerusalem." His most famous quote is, "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven." With profound statements such as these, you may be thinking that Carlo's parents were devout Catholics and brought him to Mass often. On the contrary, Carlo's parents were nominal Catholics and rarely attended Mass. It was Carlo who managed to get himself to Mass. His mother admits that it was Carlo's love for the Eucharist that inspired her to start going to Mass. At the age of 11, his focus became making known to others how important the Eucharist is in developing an intimate relationship with Jesus. So, he used his computer skills to build a website listing the Eucharistic miracles of the world.

At the age of 15, Carlo died on October 12, 2006, from an aggressive form of leukemia. He was beatified in Assisi, Italy on October 10, 2020. We can all learn much from Carlo's short life. Blessed Carlo Acutis, pray for us as we start this National Eucharistic Revival!


