I am staying at the Counseling Center which I started, (Jyothidarsana Institute for Counseling and Mental health). JyothidarsanaInstitute.

For the first 2 weeks I was visiting with my family and my community. There was a family reunion for my fathers 10th anniversary. In my <u>CMI community</u> there were many common celebrations like the Golden Jubilee of Ordinations, Nonal CMI gatherings, where I was able to meet many CMI members.

I visited my nephew, Rev. Joseph Mappilamattel at his Seminary. He has finished his Philosophy and is now doing a 2 year practical training, which will be followed by 4 years of Theology. I also visited the tomb of St Chavara Kuriakose and prayed for you all.

February 15th







Fasting and Abstinence Reminder

Church law requires abstinence from meat (for those 14 and older) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent. In addition, Ash Wednesday, and Good Friday are fast days: Those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less – no solid food between meals only one full meal and 2 smaller ones. (One's health can excuse you from these rules).



Operation Rice Bowl

Families are encouraged to eat a "poverty meal" once a week and then place the money saved in a "Rice Bowl" as a contribution for the poor which is collected on Palm Sunday, March 24th.




