



Town Of Narragansett Notice to Residents

The Town of Narragansett is utilizing its emergency alert notification system - CodeRED to collect updated contact information on residents looking to receive future notifications on how and where to register for the COVID-19 vaccination.

All Residents are encouraged to sign up for CodeRED and create a managed account.

Going forward all residents will be directed to our town website where they will be provided COVID-19 information and a link to sign-up for CodeRED.

This process is intended to provide the town a more efficient mechanism for the collection of contact data for the purpose of broadcasting future COVID-19 vaccination information to eligible residents as more vaccine becomes available.

As vaccine does become available - eligible residents will be contacted via CodeRED and provided the information and link on how and where to register for the vaccine. Those who have previously provide updated contact information through Town Hall will have their data uploaded into CodeRED via Narragansett EMA. **There is no reason to call Town Hall again.**

At the top of the page click on *COVID-19 Vaccination Information and Other Resources*. Residents must setup a **managed account** within CodeRED. When signing up residents will be able to choose their most appropriate community contact group in the **"Additional Notifications"** section of CodeRED.

Rhode Island COVID-19 Vaccination Special Update- as of February 17, 2021

The Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) is sharing an important update on the COVID-19 vaccine rollout.

COVID-19 Vaccine Registration at State-Run Sites Now Open to Rhode Islanders 75 and Older

All Rhode Islanders 75 and older can now register for an appointment at one of the two State-run vaccination sites.

The two State-run vaccination sites will open tomorrow, Thursday, February 18, for age-based vaccinating. Site locations are:

- Dunkin' Donuts Center 1 La Salle Square in Providence, RI 02903
- 100 Sockanosset Cross Road in Cranston, RI 02920

Other options for vaccination still include going to a select retail pharmacy, or a local or regional clinic. Because there are multiple ways to get a vaccine, RIDOH encourages people to only schedule an appointment in one place so that all eligible people can get vaccinated as quickly as possible. Once an appointment is made, people are guaranteed a vaccine for their time slot.

Beginning Monday, February 22, appointment slots will be expanded to any Rhode Islander 65 and older. Individuals 65-74 years old can begin registering for an appointment on Monday, February 22.

Registering for Vaccination at a State-run Site

To register to be vaccinated at one of the State-run sites, visit vaccinateri.org. People who cannot register online can get help by calling the automated line at 844-930-1779. Going forward, the call center will be open on weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. and weekends from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (closed on holidays). Through both systems, an individual can either make a personal appointment or an appointment for someone else who is 75 years of age or older.

Appointments are currently open through February 27. Appointments are expected to fill up quickly, so people may need to try multiple times before they are able to schedule.

Registering for Vaccination at a Pharmacy

People who are 75 years of age and older can contact CVS or Walgreens about appointments at a retail pharmacy location. To register, people can go to CVS.com, use the CVS Pharmacy phone app, or call 800-746-7287. For Walgreens, go to Walgreens.com/ScheduleVaccine or call your local Walgreens.

Registering for Vaccination at a Local or Regional Clinic

Cities and towns are managing the registration process for local and regional clinics. Most cities and towns have been vaccinating their oldest residents first and will continue to do so. People can contact their city or town directly to learn more.

South County Hospital has been authorized by the Rhode Island Department of Health to offer a limited number of vaccines to those 75 years of age and older who meet eligibility requirements.

Individuals who meet the pre-registration eligibility requirements will be contacted via South County Health in the order registered for additional screening. Go to: <https://www.southcountyhealth.org/quick-links/covid-vaccine-clinic>

Vaccine clinics are currently scheduled for:

- Monday, Feb. 22
- Wednesday, Feb. 24
- Friday, Feb. 26

Appointments will be scheduled from 9 am to 4 pm. There will be no walk-in appointments.

Vaccine Interest Notification List

While people who are younger than 75 years of age cannot yet register to be vaccinated, they can add their contact information to a state Vaccine Interest Notification List to get updates as eligibility opens to new groups. Enrolling in this list does not guarantee an appointment for vaccination. To enroll in the Vaccine Interest Notification List, visit portal.ri.gov.

There is no insurance requirement to get vaccinated, and no one has to pay to get vaccinated. For more information about vaccination in Rhode Island, visit C19vaccineRI.org.


