

SEEK and you will find!

I was blessed to attend the SEEK Conference in Salt Lake City, which was attended by over 19,000 Catholic college and post-college students. The conference was sponsored by FOCUS, which, as you know, is an organization of missionaries who serve around the country at colleges. We are blessed to have a team here at URI.

While I was there, I was helping at the booth for the Archdiocese for Military Services alongside our chaplain recruiters and members of Team St. Paul. These missionaries serve similarly to FOCUS on military installations in the US.

In addition to the location in Salt Lake City, there was an overflow conference in Washington, DC, of several thousand.

On Friday evening, 270 priests heard over 5,500 confessions in a huge space. It was truly an overwhelming experience of grace in my priesthood.

Here in New England, we are experiencing a contracting Church of sorts, but I have witnessed at both the recent SEEK Conference in Utah, and at the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis this summer (where there were 55,000 Catholics gathered in a Eucharistic revival), that the Church is in fact, young, vibrant, missionary and Eucharistic! At both events it was also great to see in attendance countless religious brothers and sisters.

This year, Pope Francis has called us to enter the Jubilee Year of Hope. I have been filled with hope by all I have witnessed. I pray you too, can be full of hope in Jesus Christ, who is with us yesterday, today, and forever.

The SEEK conference was held at the Salt Palace Convention Center

in Salt Lake City from Jan. I-5, 2025. This year, SEEK25 drew many clergy, with 46 bishops and hundreds of priests in attendance in Salt Lake City and Washington, D.C. which was SEEK's secondary location. Fort Worth, in addition to Columbus, and Denver, will host SEEK26 next year.





The exuberant crowd of mostly young adults grew quiet when the opening Mass began, which took place the night of New Year's Day on the feast of Mary, Mother of God, at SEEK25 in Salt Lake City. Centered on evangelism, the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) which hosts SEEK, sends missionaries to college campuses to minister to college students.




