#### This and That...

I want to begin by thanking the Knights of Columbus for last weekend's great May breakfast. And thanks to all of you who attended, as your generous support helped the Knights raise funds for those in need in our community.

As you may have read in a prior bulletin, we recently hosted one of the Diocesan marriage prep programs at St. Thomas More in the parish hall. There were sixty-two brides and grooms preparing for sacramental marriages throughout the diocese. Our presenting couples made us proud, and we have thirty-one reasons to believe the Lord continues to call and love couples to matrimony.

You may notice two new flagpoles at St. Veronica Chapel. These were installed as the final part of the parking lot expansion project and will fly the American and Vatican flags. Watch your mail for the "Summer Fest 25" flyer and raffle tickets! The event will occur on Sunday, June 29th, at the Feast of SS. Peter and Paul start with Mass at 11:00 AM, followed by a blessing of the flags and flagpoles; then, we will raise the flags for the first time. The BBQ celebration begins at noon and will include food, live music by the Driftwoods, and a magician for the children.

St. Thomas More will also be getting a flagpole that has been donated as a memorial, which will fly both flags as well. We hope to bless and fly the flags the weekend of July 4th. Thank you to the donor!

We saved two parking lot light poles from the old St. Veronica Parking lot that will be placed on the islands of St. Thomas More parking lot islands. The parking lot is dark at night, and more light is needed. We will fund this project with the last of the capital campaign funds. This should happen within a few weeks and will take about four days.

You may see some activity around the St. Veronica parking lot retention pond. The engineering company is making improvements. The parish is not responsible nor contributing to the costs of this project in any way.

Let's keep our hearts open, pews open, and parking places open to hospitality with smiles on our faces as the Lord brings so many visitors and pilgrims to South County!

**Mini Reflection:** In today's Gospel, Jesus prays for me. And for you. And for all the people who woke up this morning and headed to Mass because, while it's true that God is everywhere, the Body and Blood of Jesus is only found in one place.

#### That the World May Believ

I love today's Gospel because, in it, Jesus prays for me.

And you.

And the guy sitting next to you at Mass. And the priest, and the altar server, and all the people in all the churches in all the towns in all the world who woke up this morning and headed to Mass because, while it's true that God is everywhere, the Body and Blood of Jesus is only found in one place.

And he prays for the barista who will sell you your coffee later today and see your crucifix and hear you say, "God bless," and think, "That's a weird necklace, and I don't believe in God," but who will one day, at her lowest point, wonder if anyone ever truly loved her, and remember the sight of that broken and bloodied Corpus.

Today, Jesus prays for the person you passed on the way into the parking lot this morning, the one who doesn't go to Mass anymore but who always walks his dog on this street, on this morning, for reasons he can't explain.

He prays for your great-great grandparents and your great-great grandchildren.

"Those who will believe in me through their word." That's me. That's you. That's us. We're the ones who believe through the word of the Apostles, who bore witness to the life and death and Resurrection of the God-Man, Jesus Christ, and whose testimony to that life is an eternal flame illuminating the understanding of every human being who will ever say, "I believe."

But if we listen to what Jesus says today, we must understand: it's not just the Apostles' job, and it's not done. It's not a book that is closed. It's a mission that is alive and ongoing, and it's as much ours as it was theirs: that the world may believe that you sent me.

### Why do we do that? Catholic Life Explained

#### Question:

What is Lectio Divina, and how is it associated with the Benedictine Monastic tradition, whose founder, St. Benedict, we honor on July 11?

#### Answer:

Benedict desired his monks to live in community, praying the Liturgy of the Hours together, contemplating sacred texts, and doing manual labor. The monks developed a technique to facilitate a spiritual and devotional reading of the Bible known as Lectio Divina, the holy reading of a text. This method encourages the reader to hear the biblical text with an open heart and focus on whatever God wants to highlight and then apply it to daily life.

There are variations on Lectio Divina, but essentially, the technique consists of a three-step process of reflection. When the reflection is done with a group, the responses are shared by all the participants. Once the text is selected, it is read meditatively. and the following are then explored: a word or phrase that attracts you; how and where the content of this reading touches your life today; what you believe that God wants you to do during this coming week (month, year, lifetime).

Thanks to Benedict, the Christian community has been gifted with this special way of entering into the biblical text. This week, use the Lectio Divina process on one of the readings for the coming Sunday and make a note of the life connections you are making. How is this reflection on the biblical text drawing you closer to God and others?

Collation in Parish Hall to Follow


An icon of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be the centerpiece of a special Sacred Heart Holy Hour

During the holy hour, an icon depicting the most famous image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, painted in 1767 by Pompeo Batoni and now venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome, will be displayed. This reproduction of the original image bears the blessing of Pope Francis and is one of more than 300 icons traveling across the world as part of the Knights of Columbus Pilgrim Icon Program.

The Sacred Heart Holy Hour will include readings from Sacred Scripture and reflections from Pope Francis on the Sacred Heart of Jesus, as well as the Divine Mercy Chaplet, prayers to the Sacred Heart, and time for silent prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The prayer service will lead all present to grow in their love of God and devotion to his Most Sacred Heart.


