ST. VERONICA PARKING LOT ENHANCEMENT





View of the parking lot from Carol Lane upon completion.

(Carol Lane is adjacent to St. Veronica Chapel).

The parking lot at St. Veronica Chapel will be going through a significant improvement project starting in April 2023, lasting through the summer with projected completion for September. The improvements include:

- Compliance with previous zoning requirements regarding the number of parking spaces required at the time the chapel and classrooms were built.
- Meeting OSHA handicap parking and accessibility codes
- Reduction of on-street parking
- Providing safer entrance and exits
- Providing a safe drop off lane for children/other persons going to activities on parish property
- Creation of a retention basin to significantly reduce runoff, thus increasing water quality to nearby critical coastal resources
- Extensive natural landscaping to buffer the perimeter with the adjacent neighborhood

On Saturdays and Sundays, the parking lot will be accessible during scheduled Mass times. We appreciate our countless donors who generously donated to this project. We know they value the enormous improvements in safety for our parishioners and those we serve. We are deeplygrateful to the many professionals who have worked over the last five years to facilitate all necessary approvals from civil and ecclesiastical authorities. We would like to thank all parishioners, visitors and neighbors in advance for their patience during this exciting project and improvements.


