Thank You, Archbishop-elect Richard Henning

As the old saying goes, Bishop Henning, we hardly knew you! But what we have known of him has been a great blessing to our Diocese and every parish and diocesan institution served by it. As the Auxiliary Bishop of his home Diocese, Rockville Center in New York, Bishop Henning was named by Pope Francis to be the Coadjutor Bishop of Providence in November of 2022 and at his welcoming to the Diocese in January 2023, he held up a flag of the State of Rhode Island and proclaimed that he was joyful because he could now “live in a State of Hope.” After taking over as the Bishop in April of 2023, he has visited almost all of the 120 parishes in the Diocese and he has been here at St. Thomas More several times. When he visits, he brings with him a feeling that his leadership would lead us to a better future and a stronger understanding of who we are as a Church. He has truly given us Hope.



Now, Pope Francis has named him the Archbishop of Boston and I am a bit envious of the people and clergy of Massachusetts who will benefit from his great leadership, courage, wisdom and faith. And, although he will be greatly missed here, we know that because of his short time among us, we have been greatly blessed. Join me in thanking this kind and wise Shepherd for his service to us as we pray for the Holy Spirit to send us another wise Shepherd to lead us into the future.

Change of leadership at St. Thomas More

Since my arrival here on April 15th to serve as temporary Administrator of the Parish, I have been expecting to finish my term on September 15th, at which time the Diocese would name another Administrator to serve until Fr. Taillon's expected return in December. In last week's Parish Bulletin we announced that I would be replaced by Fr. Francis Kayatta, the pastor emeritus of St. Mary Star of the Sea parish. However, sometimes God has other plans. Because of an unforeseen health problem, Fr. Kayatta will not be able to replace me. It is uncertain who will fill that role and I hope we have an answer soon. In the meantime, I am happy to continue to serve here until another priest is found. While I have enjoyed my stay here in this great Parish and I have been treated very kindly by all of you, I am of an age when I need to slow down and work less. And so, I will be happy to remain with you until I can be replaced.

Summer Mass Schedule Change

Registration for Religious Education is now open!

At St. Thomas More, our Religious Education program presents Catholic teaching using time-tested methodology and spiritual development in a beautiful, student-friendly, and comprehensive format. Each year has a systematic approach covering foundational truths of the faith as presented in the Catechism. The content of the faith unfolds through salvation history as presented in Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition, with each grade level having a specific focus. Woven throughout our program, we acquaint students with Our Blessed Mother, the angels, the saints and developing a prayer life. We use the Faith and Life series from Ignatius Press in grades one through eight. Here is an overview:

- **1st grade - Our Heavenly Father:** In first grade, students are introduced to the Holy Trinity through presentations on God the Father, the life of Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. Children also learn essential prayers.
- **2nd grade - Jesus Our Life:** Students prepare for their first reception of the sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion, with the law of God and salvation history as background. The lessons emphasize God's mercy and love. They will cover creation, the covenant with Moses, the Ten Commandments, redemption, forgiveness of sins, and the Mass.
- **3rd grade – Our Life with Jesus:** Third-grade students learn God's plan of salvation, from creation to the Incarnation, and redemption to the birth of the Church at Pentecost.
- **4th grade - Jesus Our Guide:** Students learn the many ways God helps us in our pilgrimage on earth to heaven through His Word, His law, and His Church. The narrative of salvation history points students toward Jesus Christ, who fulfills Old Testament promises.
- **5th grade - Credo: I Believe:** Fifth-grade students study the articles of the Creed as the fundamental belief of our Catholic faith. They learn to distinguish truths of our faith from errors that lead us away from God.
- **6th grade - Following Christ:** Sixth-grade students learn the blueprint for a life of love by studying the Ten Commandments and the Holy Mass.
- **7th grade - The Life of Grace:** Seventh-grade students learn that grace is God's gift to us. There is an emphasis on the transmission of grace through the seven sacraments and the role of grace in developing the virtues.
- **8th grade - Our Life in the Church:** Eighth-grade students study the history of the Church - its founding by Christ, its birth in the Holy Spirit, the marks of the one true Church, the Fathers and Doctors of the Church, the saints and the role of the religious and laity.
- **9th grade - Confirmation Preparation:** Candidates prepare their hearts to receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit through continued intellectual and spiritual formation.

We are blessed to have many dedicated, veteran catechists for grades 1 through 8 and myself and Mr. George Travis as the catechists for Confirmation preparation.
