

At this year's Easter Vigil, our parish was blessed to welcome seven adults into the Catholic Church. This happened in parishes worldwide, and in the United States alone, thousands came into full communion with the Catholic Church. All these individuals went through a beautiful process called RCIA.

However, most people are unfamiliar with this process. What exactly is RCIA? RCIA is an acronym for "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults." It is much more than a course of instruction; it's a process designed to meet people's unique and individual needs on their journey of faith.

#### Who is RCIA for?

- It's for those who are interested in becoming Catholic and need to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion).
- It's for those who were baptized, either as Catholic or in another Christian faith, and need the Sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation.
- It's for those who have been baptized and received Holy Communion but never received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- It's also for those seeking to learn more about the Catholic Church.

The Church expresses this process best. "The Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA)...is designed for adults who, after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God and enter the way of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. With God's help, they will be spiritually strengthened during their preparation and will receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the proper time." (Introduction to RCIA, 1)
